This information shall be made available with consistent documentation and consolidated for easy access by the Upstream Sub-committee. • The Coordinator is responsible to work with the corresponding upstream projects, as a liaison, in order to meet Akraino best practice requirements (that will be developed by this Sub-Committee, see next item.) • The Coordinators should work within the Upstream Sub-committee meeting to report status, resolve issues, and document best practices. • The Coordinators can share their roles as the liaison to a common upstream project.
